Röhlig Deutschland: New head of Frankfurt air freight gateway

Frankfurt/Main. Alexander Verges is the new head of Röhlig's own air freight gateway at Frankfurt/Main airport. A logistics graduate with first-hand knowledge of the air freight business, 34-year-old Alexander Verges made a name for himself during the gateway set-up process. After working in logistics in the Export Consol department, he was appointed as department head in 2004. In this role, he played a significant part in establishing the gateway, created through the merger of the Export Consol and Import Hub in March 2012.

With Alexander Verges at the helm, the aim is to steadily expand the gateway's services and activities. At present, Röhlig Deutschland regularly offers transport services to 70 destinations, with most locations served by several flights a week.
