3. PURPOSES FOR WHICH PERSONAL DATA ARE TO BE PROCESSED

Data reconciliation within the framework of sanctions list checks is carried out in order to comply with EU embargo regulations relating to individuals and countries (including anti-terror provisions). After this prohibition of provision, neither funds nor other economic resources may be made directly or indirectly available to the persons listed there.

4. LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING

The data are processed on the basis of Art. 6 f) UK-GDPR.

5. LEGITIMATE INTERESTS OF THE RESPONSIBLE PARTY

The prohibition of provision described under point 3 can be violated by non-compliance with (Freedom) punishments and fines for those responsible.

6. RECIPIENTS/CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS

The data (first name, surname, email address, address) will be processed within the Röhlig Group for software-supported data synchronization.
