

2021/22 Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB) Season Sea Cargo from Italy to NZ

- BMSB Season runs from 1st September to 30th April
- All Commodities ex Italy are considered "High Risk" therefore require OFFSHORE treatment-click here, unless approved prior to arrival by MPI as a Sensitive Risk Goods. See Full List-click here
- Untreated High Risk Cargo WILL NOT be allowed to come ashore in most instances
- All offshore treatment must be supported by a BMSB Treatment Certificate, carried out by an MPI approved offshore treatment provider. click here
- Fully enclosed sea container(six-sided metal sea containers) must be sealed within 24 hours of treatment and remain sealed

LCL Cargo: Heat treated in Italy


Alternative Mehtyl Bromide Fumigation in transit via Singapore
